Please order your plants ASAP to help us organize our sales and to ensure we are able to fill your order. We will fill orders on a first come basis based on when we receive your order. The sooner you get your order in the more likely we'll be able to fill it completely. We don't recommend planting until Mother's Day. All plants will be in 4 inch pots so you should be able to keep them healthy until planting time.
