We are planning to deliver to Jenkins Garden Market on Saturday May 3 from 9:00 to 11:00. On Wednesday May 7 we'll be there 4:00 to 6:00. On Saturday May 10 we'll be there 9:00 to 11:00. Please indicate which date you plan to pick up your plants. You can also schedule a time to pick up your plants at the farm.

All plants will be \$4 each or a full flat of 18 plants for \$66 (\$3.50 each after first 18).

Please order your plants ASAP to help us organize our sales and to ensure we are able to fill your order. We will fill orders on a first come basis based on when we receive your order. The sooner you get your order in the more likely we'll be able to fill it completely. We don't recommend planting until Mother's Day. All plants will be in 4 inch pots so you should be able to keep them healthy until planting time. We use a certified organic compost and the plants are chemical free.

____Amish Paste
Meaty fruits, good for sauce or fresh eating.

____Aunt Ruby's German Green
Beefsteak fruit, refreshing flavor, green ripe, large over one pound.

____Black Krim
Purple red, turn almost black. Full flavor.

____Brandywine
One of the best tasting tomatoes, luscious flavor, large over one pound, deep pink skin and smooth red flesh.

____Cherokee Purple
Extremely sweet flavor, productive plants, dusty rose colored.

____Crnkovic Yugoslavian
Pink beefsteak. Up to a pound each. Rarely crack. Full tomato flavor.

Luscious pink beefsteaks weighing up to one pound.
Dr. Wyche's Yellow Heavy yields of 1 lb golden yellow tomatoes. Meaty flesh and rich flavor.
Federle Very few seeds, excellent for processing, especially for salsa.
German Pink Full sweet flavor. Excellent for canning, freezing, and slicing. 1 to 2 lb beefsteak.
Giant Syrian Huge red delicious, full flavor. Good producer for us.
Gold Medal Very little acid, very sweet, yellow streaked red.
Green Zebra Green striped salad specialty, sweet zingy flavor.
Hungarian Heart Huge ox heart, few seeds, fresh eating, canning, and for fresh roasted tomato sauce.
Italian Heirloom Excellent full tomato flavor, easy to peel, ideal for slicing and canning.
Kellogg's Breakfast Beef steak type fruits from one to two pounds, juicy meaty and orange in color.
Martinos Roma Mild-flavored meaty productive paste tomato. Heavy set of 2-3 ounce fruits perfect for sauce salsa and paste.
